

All campers will participate in a leadership class, a low ropes class and a high ropes class.  
The remaining classes will be selected from the list below...

<b>any class in blue</b>	will require the camper to pass the swim test
<b>Archery</b>	Practice your skills, or pick up a bow for the first time. Ready, aim, FIRE!!!
<b>Arts and Crafts</b>	Friendship Bracelets, Boondoggle, and other various camp crafts.
<b>Beach</b>	Take a swim or relax on the sand.
<b>Climbing Tower</b>	Join a group of fellow campers in an attempt to climb our 40ft rock wall!
<b>Field Games/ Sports</b>	This class will vary based on what each group wants to play, options will include GA GA, basket ball, volleyball, kickball, frisbee, can jam and corn hole.
<b>Hammock Hill</b>	Pick a spot, read a book or take a nap in your hammock on the hill.
<b>Hike to the Rock</b>	Enjoy scenic views of Rock and Trout ponds when you take a hike here!
<b>Horse Trail Ride</b>	This class is focused on saddling up and getting out on our trails!
<b>Kayaking Long</b>	Go on a water adventure on Long and Round pond!
<b>Kayaking Trout</b>	Go on a water adventure on Rock and Trout pond!
<b>Mountain Biking</b>	Hop on one of our mountain bikes and cruise down our wooded trails. The ability to ride a bike is required, but advanced skills are not necessary.
<b>Nature Art</b>	Take a walk in the woods and discover art nature. This class will include creating art with natural materials.
<b>Photography in Nature</b>	Take a hike with some of our camp photographers and try to catch some beautiful nature shots.
<b>Stand Up Paddle Board</b>	Try our newest and most rewarding water activity
<b>Stream Stomp</b>	Wander in the creek and collect all sorts of insects and water creatures.
<b>C.I.T</b>	Choose to be a C.I.T if you have interest in working at Oswegatchie in the future! You must be at least 15 years old to do this experience. It will include a class with the camp director and helping out your counselor at the campsite.
