Job Description for Counselor

Minimum Qualifications:

- 1. Must be graduated from high school before summer camp begins.
- 2. Must have experience in camping or working with youth ages 12 to 18.
- 3. Must have the ability to provide safe and consistent supervision.
- 4. Must have a desire to work with children in a camp environment.
- 5. Must posses and maintain a positive attitude.
- 6. Must be a positive role model in the presence of campers.
- 7. Must have the ability to earn campers' trust.
- 8. Must have the ability to communicate with campers.
- 9. Must have the ability to accept guidance and supervision.
- 10. Preferred to be at least 18 years of age
- 11. Must obtain a First Aid & CPR certification that will be less than 1 year old by the time staff training begins.

Responsible To: Program Director

<u>General Responsibility</u>: To carry out and supervise the summer camp program.

Specific Responsibilities:

- 1. Participate in a 10 day training program prior to campers arriving.
- 2. Supervise campers in a safe and consistent manner, as well as insuring quality experience.
- 3. Maintain campsite so that it is safe and free from hazards. Report any maintenance problems.
- 4. Report injuries of anyone under you supervision to the medical director.
- 5. Share concerns with camp management as needed.
- 6. Provide direct and around the clock supervision for 10 to 15 campers. This includes overnight at campsites away from main camp.
- 7. Supervise and delegate responsibilities to the CIT's when appropriate.
- 8. Assist the Ropes Coordinator in supervision and implementation of the low and high ropes programs.
- 9. Assist and advise campers through registration on Sunday.
- 10. Supervise campsite through daily campsite and main camp details / clean up.
- 11. Instruct and supervise camp programs as assigned by the Program Director.
- 12. Lead trips for hiking, biking, canoes, and kayaks.
- 13. Lead environmental and leadership education classes as trained.
- 14. Assist in other duties that occur around the camp as needed. This includes cleaning, firewood, food service help, maintenance assistance, etc.
